Full description

The Dutch company focuses on the procurement and further processing of high-quality natural shells that serve as raw material for the production of shell grit. This shell grit is used in the animal feed sector, where it functions as a source of calcium and as a structural component in feed for various animal categories.

The company works exclusively with mineral shell material. The shells consist of calcium carbonate in the form of calcite or aragonite (CaCO) and contain no animal material, meat, or meat residues. The primary focus is on shells originating from bivalve mollusks such as oysters, cockles, mussels, scallops, and clams. Marine snail shells are also permitted, provided they are not too large and fall within the specified size range.

To ensure optimal grinding and processing, the company applies strict specifications regarding material size. The shells must have a dimension between 2 and 50 mm. Material smaller than 1 mm is not accepted, while shells larger than 50 mm are not preferred.

By combining these quality and sustainability standards with specialized processing expertise, the company delivers a reliable, clean, and consistent raw material for the animal feed industry.
